Together, let's prevent thefts in our region by:

- being observant...
- by drawing up an inventory of your assets...
- by engraving your precious assets...
- by reporting suspicious events...

OBSERVATIONS

You are the person who knows your environment best and who can provide essential information to the police. Be on the lookout for things that arouse your suspicions. For example, if you see a suspicious vehicle, note:

- the brand
- the model
- the color
- the license plate number
- particularities

INVENTORY

- Take inventory of all your belongings. Note the make, model, color and serial number of each item.
- Keep this inventory in a safe place, ideally out of the house (safety box or even an email). If you were the victim of theft, it could be useful to the police.
- It is also recommended to photograph your objects.

Avoid leaving certain items outside your cottage - tools, ladders, or objects that could be used to break windows or force locks.

ENGRAVING

- Using an engraver, engrave your driver's license number on your valuables. Items so marked have little appeal to thieves and resellers.
- The Association has a chisel available to borrow. Contact us to use it.
